4. Board member updates

- Board member updates
 - Don Mullin expressed a desire to see more apprenticeship opportunities in emerging careers and to expand the influence of the apprenticeship models across other industries.
 - Tom Dicklich announced that a new cohort for Building Strong Communities will be starting soon, with 130 apprentices ready to join the workforce and begin their apprenticeship journey.
 - Sophie Thaden indicated the Minneapolis plumbers JATC will be opening applications in January and are looking forward to a busy season.

5. Clean Economy Grant

- Lori Blair, Executive Director of Minnesota Rural Water Association and Joe Jasmer, Apprenticeship Program Coordinator shared their mission for the Clean Economy Grant awarded to their apprenticeship program.
 - Focus on rural areas in Minnesota with population under 10,000.
 - Provide training to apprentices to keep their certification up for specific licenses.
 - Address the nationwide shortage of water and wastewater resources.
- Clean Economy Grant Advantages
 - High Tech equipment for apprentices to learn and gain experience.
 - Rural communities are modernized and updated with the high tech equipment.

- Paul Nikstad and LaRohn Latimer, both Senior Field Representatives from Minnesota Department of Labor and Industry, provided an update on new programs from the last quarter.
 - Neighborhood Health (Healthcare)
 - Traut Companies (Construction)
 - Patisserie 46 (Hospitality)
- Program Development Highlights
 - Accelerator Meetings (Healthcare, Information Technology and Manufacturing).
 - Additional programs continue to be developed in the semiconductor industry and education.
 - New and expanded Apprenticeship programs grants.
 - Up to 30k per applicant
 - o 30 people attended informational webinar

7. Apprenticeship Program Compliance

- Jeremy Parker and Meghana Shroff, Senior Field Representatives from Minnesota Department of Labor and Industry, provided an update on program reviews.
 - 166 reviews completed; 32 reviews completed in the last quarter.
 - Continued reduction in overdue apprentices.
 - Successful trial-runs with new RAPIDS program review process.
- RAPIDS Program Review beginning January 2025
 - Senior Field Representative will provide extra technical assistance.
 - Online training series for programs later this spring.
 - Desk audit and follow-up summary.
